Birth to 2 weeks		Weight & Length
2 Months	Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB) Hep B, Rota Virus, Prevnar	Weight & Length
4 Months	Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB) Prevnar, Rota Virus, Hep B(If not given at birth)	Weight & Length
6 Months	Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB) Rota Virus, Flu(During Season)	
9 Months	Hep B, Prevnar, Flu (During season)	Lead & Hemoglobin, Fluoride
12 Months	MMR, Varicella, Hep A Flu(During Season)	Lead & Hemoglobin (if not done at 9 Mo.), Fluoride and Dental Referral (if not done at 6 Mo.)
15 Months	Dtap, HIB, Prevnar, Flu (During season)	M- Chat
18 Months	Hep A, Flu (During season)	Lead & Hemoglobin, M-Chat, Fluoride
2 Years	Flu(During Season)	Lead & Hemoglobin (if not done at 18 Mo.), M-Chat, Fluoride
30 Month	Flu(During Season)	M-Chat, Lead & Hemoglobin (If patient hasn't had two by this age)
3 Years	Flu(During Season)	Hearing, M-Chat, Lead & Hemoglobin (If patient hasn't had two by this age)
4 Years	Dtap, IPV, MMR, Varicella, Flu(During Season)	Vision
5-10 Years	Flu(During Season)	Vision,
11 Years	Tdap, MCV, HPV, Flu(During Season)	Vision, Lipid Panel Ages 9 - 11
12- 18 Years	MCV, HPV, Flu(During Season), Men B	Vision, Labs

- May apply Fluoride 2x per year up to age 3
- Flu vaccine is available to all patients during Flu Season(Sept. – March)
If it is the patient's 1st Flu vaccine, must have a second dose 31 days after the first
- Lab work is ordered at the discretion of the Provider
